



Zero Tolerance Policy

Ayrshire Tigers PFC now operates a Zero Tolerance Policy relating to the use of abusive language/behaviour directed at match officials, managers, spectators or players. Any person reported to the club and subsequently found guilty by the Club of using abusive language or behaviour will be dismissed from the club immediately.

Any age group reported to the SPFA or SFA for using abusive language/behaviour and found guilty could be folded immediately and withdrawn from all competitions. The consequences of using abusive language/behaviour can be far reaching. Should incidents occur that are reported to the SPFA or SFA has a number of sanctions available including;

- Suspending or withdrawing the Club affiliation, this means no Ayrshire Tigers PFC team will be allowed to play any games during the period of suspension.
- We would be ordered to forfeit all matches during the suspension period.

We have a large number of players at this club, the club has the responsibility to ensure that they are able to enjoy the game freely. We see no reason why they or their parents should pay such a high penalty for the actions of one person or a single age group.

We are each responsible for our actions, all persons involved within this Club have agreed to abide by the Club's Codes of Conduct, therefore if you find you unable to comply with the Codes of Conduct PLEASE stay away from all matches.
